Item No. SA 1: LTSA arrangement for SCADA/EMS under WR ULDC scheme

The matter regarding LTSA arrangement for SCADA/EMS under WR ULDC scheme was discussed in the 9th WRPC meeting held on 16th Jan 2009 and it was decided that the Negotiation Committee being nominated by PGCIL may negotiate the cost with M/s GE to a reasonable acceptable level and alternatively, PGCIL may go for inviting quotation etc. on limited bidding and formulate the specification. However, while formulating the specification by WRLDC/PGCIL, views of SLDCs may also be taken care of.

In this context, AGM (OS), WRLDC vide letter dated 31.03.2009 have intimated that a Committee nominated by PGCIL has negotiated with M/s GE and the negotiated price is Rs. 37.5 Crores for 5 years and one more negotiation at higher lever is to be held during April 2009.

Item No. SA 2: Utilisation of surplus amount available in REC pool account

AGM (OS), WRLDC vide letter dated 31.03.2009 (copy enclosed at Annexure-SA2) have intimated that REC pool of WRPC maintained by WRLDC has a surplus amount of Rs. 2 Crores as on date. As per clause 8 of Annexure-I of Complementary Commercial Mechanism of IEGC, the money remaining in the regional REA after pay out of all VAr charges upto 31st March of every year shall be utilized for improving/streamlining the operation of respective grids as decided by respective RPC from time to time.

WRLDC have proposed to utilize the surplus amount available in REC pool account for installation of Dynamic Power System Stability Monitoring Systems at a few locations in Western Region. They have further intimated that they have received an offer from

M/s A-Eberle Systems Pvt. Ltd for CPSus CPR-D Dynamic Power System Stability Monitoring System for which the salient features are as below:

- a) Spectral analysis with high frequency resolution
- b) Detection of collapse of system due to oscillations
- c) Analysis and evaluation of system dynamics
- d) Measurement of network damping
- e) Real time calculation of system stability exponent
- f) Detection of gradual network breakdowns
- g) Frequency relay functions
- h) Fault record functions
- i) Differentiated signaling strategy

WRLDC have proposed to constitute a Committee with Members from both the Protection Committee and Commercial Committee to identify some strategic locations in Western Region where this system can be placed. This would help in monitoring the system dynamics to prevent voltage collapse, suppress oscillations, tune df/dt relay setting etc.

WRLDC is requested to make presentation to the Committee members. Committee may like to discuss.
